

Applicability of Texas Education Code Relating to Special Education

An open-enrollment charter school is subject to a prohibition, restriction, or requirement, as applicable, imposed by Title 2 (Public Education) of the Texas Education Code, or a rule adopted under Title 2 (Public Education) of the Texas Education Code, relating to special education programs under Subchapter A (Special Education Program), Chapter 29, Texas Education Code. (TEC §12.104(b)(2)(F)). The Universal Academy open-enrollment charter school adopts the requirements of Subchapter A (Special Education Program), Chapter 29, Texas Education Code pursuant to TEC §12.104(b)(2)(F).

Assurance

Pursuant to the Individuals with Disabilities in Education Act (IDEA), open-enrollment charter schools must submit a plan to the Texas Education Agency that provides assurances that the open-enrollment charter school has in effect policies, procedures, and programs that are consistent with the State and Federal policies and procedures governing special education.
